#### **Description:**

A unique single component, one coat\* paint for tiled surfaces. Flag Tile Paint is made using a special blend of resins producing an easy to apply product, with excellent adhesion, colour retention, water resistance and durability. The product is ideally suited for home\*\* kitchen and bathroom areas. Designed to produce a high quality finish with minimal brush marks. Grouting can be coloured using a purpose designed grout pen.

*\*Additional coats may be required for extreme colour changes.*

*\*\*Commercial areas can be in constant contact with water and extreme abrasion, in such cases we recommend the use of Flag Tile Paint Clear topcoat for additional durability.*

Finish: Gloss

Volume solids: 52%

Theoretical spreading rate: 20 sq. metres per litre

Flash point: 38°C

Specific gravity: 1.15

Dry to touch: 2 hours (20°C)

Overcoating time: 4-8 hours

*\*The theoretical spreading rate has been calculated for the stated volume solids and dry film thickness. A practical spreading rate will depend on the actual dry film thickness, the nature of the substrate, and the relevant consumption factor. The physical constants are subject to normal manufacturing tolerances.*

#### **Application Details:**

Application method: Brush/Roller  
*Recommended rollers are short pile sheepskin or synthetic fibre  
Foam rollers are not recommended*

Thinner: White Spirit  
Cleaning of tools: White Spirit

**Surface condition:** The surface should be stable, firm, dry and free of dust, sand, loose old paint, dirt, grease and oil.
